

Woodwork — What's Included & Guaranteed

Our standard system (included)

- Full strip to bare timber where required for long-term adhesion and a uniform finish.
- Clean/degrease; repairs to minor defects; resin/epoxy fillers as needed.
- Dust control with M-class vacuum and on-tool extraction; no dry sweeping.
- Lead-safe methods where legacy coatings are suspected (containment, wet methods, licensed disposal).
- Prime/undercoat per spec; stain-blocking where needed; sanding between coats.
- Eco-friendly low-VOC topcoats to your chosen sheen/colour.
- Masking and protection of adjacent surfaces; tidy work areas; responsible waste disposal.
- Inter-coat inspections and a walkthrough on completion.

Warranty — when it applies

- Our full woodwork guarantee applies only when we perform the full strip-to-bare timber plus our full coating system.
- Guarantee excludes failures caused by moisture ingress, movement, impact/abrasion, cleaning with harsh chemicals, or unapproved over-painting.
- Timber must be dry and sound at the time of coating; we may postpone work if readings are high.

Paint-over option (by request)

- If you ask us to paint over existing coatings without a full strip, adhesion/peeling is excluded from guarantee.
- This must be recorded on a signed Variation and will be noted on your paperwork.

Client preparation & access

- Clear access to woodwork and remove fragile items from adjacent areas.

Your space, your vision – our mission to make it a reality for you, naturally.

- Provide power, lighting, and adequate ventilation during and after work.
- Keep pets and children away from wet coatings and work areas until dry.
- Ensure parking/access for materials and tools where possible.

Aftercare

- Allow coatings to fully cure before heavy use; light handling typically after 24–48 hours (ambient-dependent).
- Clean with a soft cloth and mild detergent; avoid harsh chemicals and abrasive pads.
- Do not apply adhesive tapes directly to freshly coated surfaces.

Variations & extras (quoted separately)

- Joinery repairs beyond minor filling; splices; resin consolidants.
- Hardware removal/refit and new ironmongery.
- Specialist finishes (e.g., colour-matched lacquers, hand-painted kitchens).
